



The following insert is designed to be used with the Deluxe Story Book, rewarded to some backers as part of the Forest of Fate Kickstarter campaign. It aims to clarify and resolve two minor misprints in this edition of the game.

Please print this page and cut out the insert below, keeping it with your Story Book. You can either insert it loosely, or glue it into the front or back cover.

To navigate these issues even more smoothly, I recommend marking the Torrent encounter card with a highlighter or sticker, to serve as a reminder to check the insert when encountering that card. You could even use smaller stickers to write in the correct paragraph numbers (taken from the insert below) over the top of the incorrect numbers.

It is possible that a corrected Torrent card will be issued with future expansions or sequels, so for that reason I would advise against permanently marking the affected paragraphs in your story book.

The digital story book (accessible via the QR code or link printed in the rulebook) already accounts for these issues by double-checking which encounter you're facing before any of the affected paragraphs are revealed. If you're playing using a smartphone, there's nothing more you need to do.

These mistakes were due to some last-minute changes in the pre-production process, which should have been reviewed more carefully. I apologise again for not picking this up prior to going to print, and want to thank everyone for their continuing show of support for Forest of Fate, irrespective of these issues.

# DON'T PANIC!

This edition of Forest of Fate has a couple of minor printing errors you should be aware of when adventuring.

Whenever an outcome says you should become **"Panicked"**, apply the **"Reckless"** status card instead.

Should you face the **Torrent** encounter, ignore the paragraph numbers on the card and use the following numbers instead:

**TORRENT**

Thunder rolls in overhead as the heavens open. You've never seen so much rain. Within minutes a strong current rises where you stand, in what must be an old river bed. You're going to get washed away!
